

Chief Minister to throw open Vanjarpatti flyover

Travel from Thane to Wada in minutes

Mumbai, November 24, 2015 – The Honourable Chief Minister of Maharashtra Mr. Devendra Fadnavis will throw open the 785 meter long flyover at Vanjarpatti in Bhiwandi, tomorrow at 12.30 p.m. The flyover will take motorists from Thane to Wada in only a few minutes. This flyover also provides additional arms – one running from Shivaji Chowk towards Nashik Highway (380 meters) and the other running from Vanjarpatti towards Shivaji Chowk (320 meters).

The Chief Minister will also perform Bhoomipujan for another 3-km long flyover on the Bhiwandi-Kalyan Road which will run from Rajiv Gandhi Chowk to Saibaba Mandir.

Both the flyovers are aimed at reducing traffic chaos, travel time and pollution that is being caused by heavy vehicular traffic. While the Vanjarpatti flyover has come to the metropolitan region at the cost of Rs. 62 crore, the proposed flyover from Rajiv Gandhi Chowk to Saibaba Mandir is estimated to cost Rs. 150 crore.
